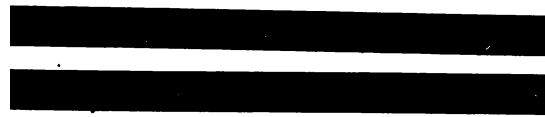
LOCATION AND HOW LOCATED: MI 0.0 Mile SW, proceed west on gravel road. MI 0.2, turn right and follow main gravel road. MI 0.5, turn right and follow Iron Mountain signs to Lockhart 1.1 mile. Follow steep road down the north side of mountain 1.1 mi to claim.

NAME OF COMPANY, HISTORY, PRODUCTION AND WORKINGS: No previous work on property. Present work is reworked and trenched area approximately 150 feet in diameter and one mile to the east.

RESULTS:  
Rokor (TV 38), Geiger counter background 0.00712/hr; maximum 0.15412/hr

DESCRIPTION OF SITE (Discuss under: A. Topography, B. Geology, C. Lithology)

- A. The property is in a saddle of a ridge extending north from Iron Mountain. Vegetation and overburden are thick.
- B. Rock exposed by 'donor' work is very altered and decomposed quartz biotite gneiss. Similar rock outcrops both east and west of the workings, but is relatively unaltered. The slight radioactivity was noted on the southeast side of an irregular one foot zone of manganese oxide trending N. 35 E. Small pieces count 3-5 times background on a Geiger counter.
- C. No radioactive minerals were noted. Present top and lithologic similarity to Iron Mountain claims indicate that radioactivity may be due to thorium.
